



Defensive and Competitive Bidding	
Overcalls (Style; Responses; Reopening)	
Aggressive Responses: Jumps show suit and fit; 2NT is supp on M Unassuming cue-bids. Direct jump-raises are pre-emptive.	
1 NT overcall (2ND/4TH; Responses; Reopening)	
2nd: 15-18 bal (subs auction as after 1nt opening) 4th Live: 11-14 NT System is off	
Jump Overcalls (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)	
2nd: 15-18 bal, system off 4th Live: 11-14 NT System is off	
Jump Overcalls (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)	
Aggressive style Weak, 5-card possible (1M)-2NT=♣+♦	
Direct and Jump Cue Bids (Style; Responses)	
Aggressive style (1♣)-cue = ♠-♥ (5+5+), (1♦)-cue = ♠-♥, (1M)-cue=OM+m, Jump cue = Asks for stopper.	
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopen: PH)	
VS strong NT Dbl : Strength 2♣ ♦ or Both majors 2♦ 5+♥ or ♠+♣ 2♥ 5+♠ or ♣+♦ 2♠ 5+♣ or ♥+♦ Bid with jump is natural, normally weak.	
VS. Preempts (Doubles; Cue bids; Jumps; NT bids)
